What to do When You Get Bumped I've been stopped by the police in public.

· You have the right to remain silent

 You do not have to consent to a search of yourself or your belongings, but police may pat down your clothing if they suspect a weapon

 In Colorado, you do have to provide proof of identity upon request; failure to do so leads to further obstruction charges

 You do not have to answer questions about where you were born, whether you are a U.S. citizen, or how you entered the country



What to do When You Get Bumped I've been pulled over by the police

Both drivers and passengers have the right to remain silent

 If you're a passenger, you can ask if you're free to leave. If yes, you may silently leave.

 In Colorado, you do have to provide proof of identity upon request; failure to do so leads to further obstruction charges

 If you have been arrested by police, you have the right to make a local phone call.
The police cannot listen if you call a lawyer.
They can and often will listen to a call made to anyone else.

What to do if you are arrested or detained

 Say you wish to remain silent and ask for a lawyer immediately. Don't give any explanations or excuses. Don't say anything, sign anything, or make any decisions without a lawyer.

 If you have been arrested by police, you have the right to make a local phone call. The police cannot listen if you call a lawyer. They can and often will listen to a call made to anyone else.

What to do When You Get Bumped If you believe your rights were violated

 Write down everything you remember, including officers' badges and patrol car numbers, which agency the officers were from, and any other details. Giet contact information for witnesses.

 If you're injured, seek medical attention immediately and take photographs of your injuries.

File a written complaint with the agency's internal affairs division or civilian complaint board. In most cases, you can file a complaint anonymously if you wish.
